What is an ESCO?



- ESCO Energy Service Company
- Private sector Energy Services companies that work with public sector and private sector customers to design, develop, implement, and measure & verify Guaranteed Energy Savings Projects.
- National Association of Energy Service Companies (NAESCO) www.naesco.org





- A Guaranteed Energy Savings project is a method of funding needed infrastructure improvements
- ➤ Current utility payments are reduced by the energy and water savings generated by the infrastructure improvements. These savings are then used to pay for the infrastructure improvements.
- Savings that are identified and delineated by the ESCO company are GUARANTEED by the ESCO company
- West Virginia Code 18-5-9a and West Virginia Code 5A -3B-1 are the enabling legislation that defines the process








Utility Bills
















West Virginia Department of Corrections



Project was divided into 2 phases

Phase 1: \$4,165,054 (September 2011)

Phase 2: \$14,437,837 (August 2012)

> Scope of Work

- Lighting retrofits/upgrades (Denmar)
- Building controls upgrades (Huttonsville and Pruntytown)
- Boiler replacement (Pruntytown)
- Steam to hot water conversion (Huttonsville and Pruntytown)
- Domestic hot water boiler upgrade (Denmar)
- New central laundry (Pruntytown)
- Kitchen Hood Controls (Huttonsville and Pruntytown)
- Domestic water conservation (Huttonsville, Mt. Olive, and Pruntytown)
- Building envelope upgrades (Denmar, Huttonsville, and Mt. Olive)
- New exterior doors (Denmar)
- > Total Savings Guaranteed by Johnson Controls: \$22,460,308

Results to Date

- 1. Currently under construction
- 2. Projected completion 1-31-2014
- 3. Baseline comparison
 - October 2010 September 2011 compared to October 2012 September 2013
 - 16% reduction in electric usage (KWh)
 - 14% reduction in electric demand charges (KW)
 - 5% reduction in natural gas (Mcf) and/or fuel oil usage (Gallons)

Note: The steam to hot water conversion portion of the project at Huttonsville was started October 2013

9% reduction in water usage (KGals)
