Vision

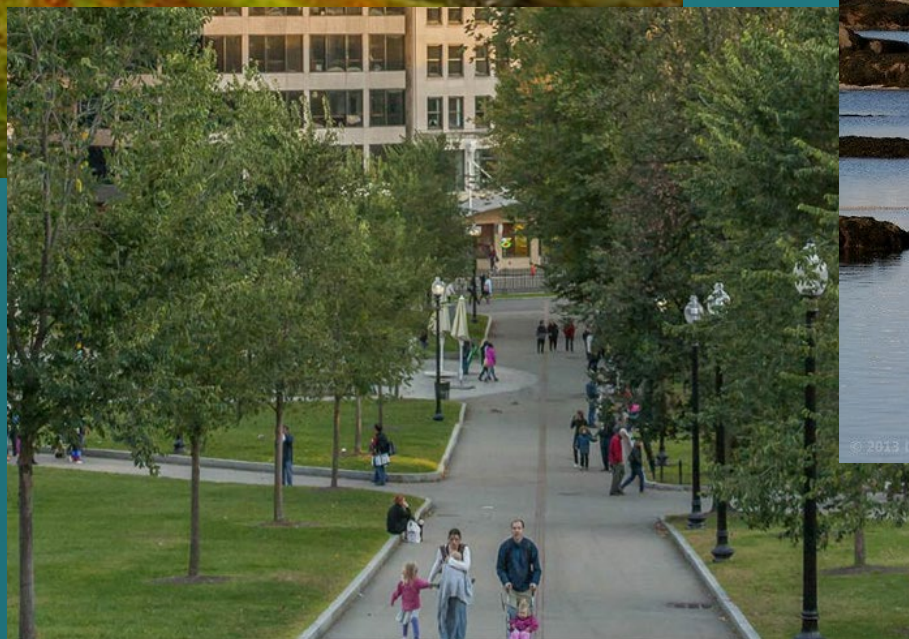
We envision the region's homes, buildings, and communities transformed into efficient, affordable, low-carbon, resilient places to live, work, and play.

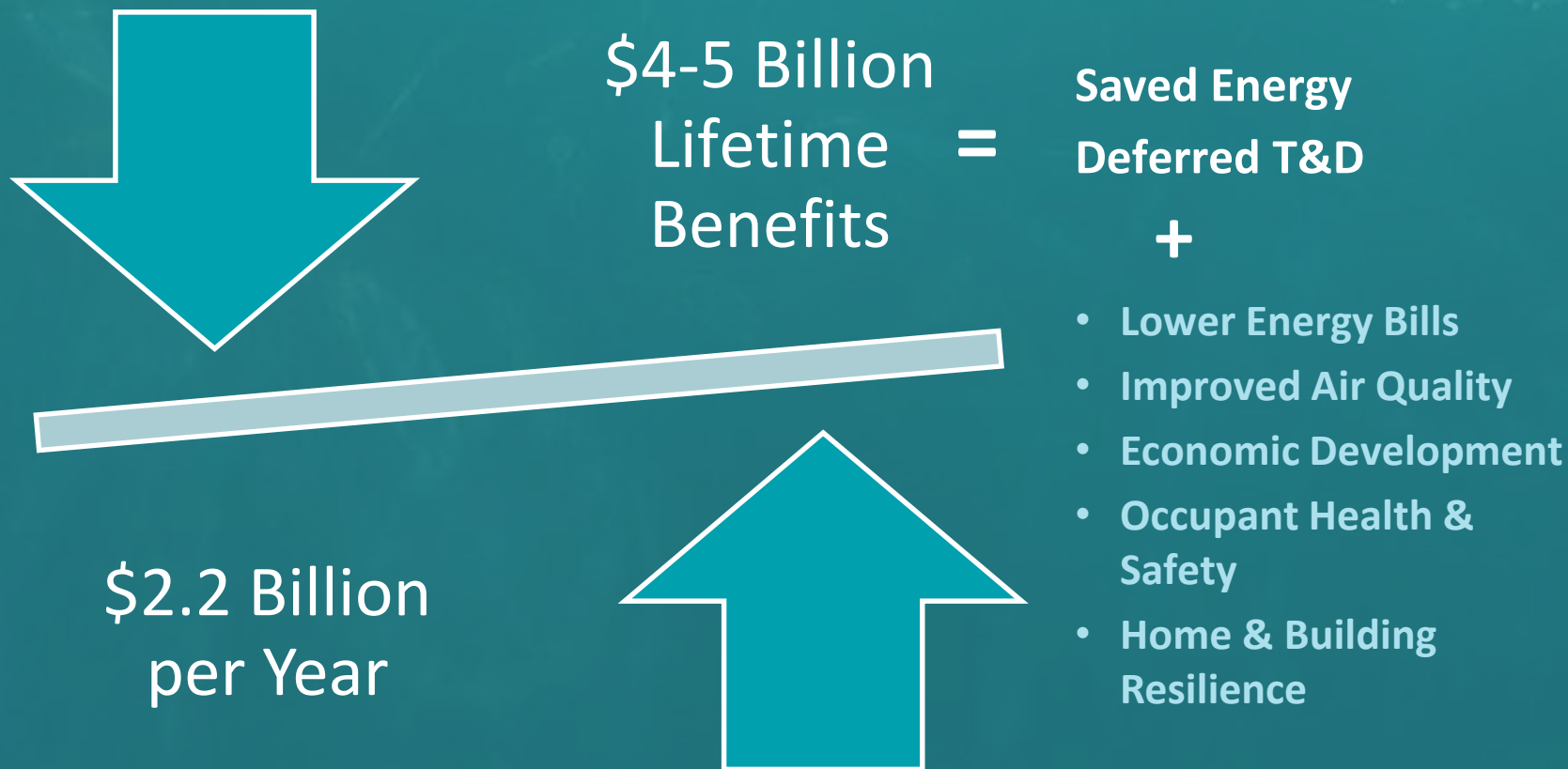

Ratepayer Funded Energy Efficiency: Annual Regional Investment – Northeast US



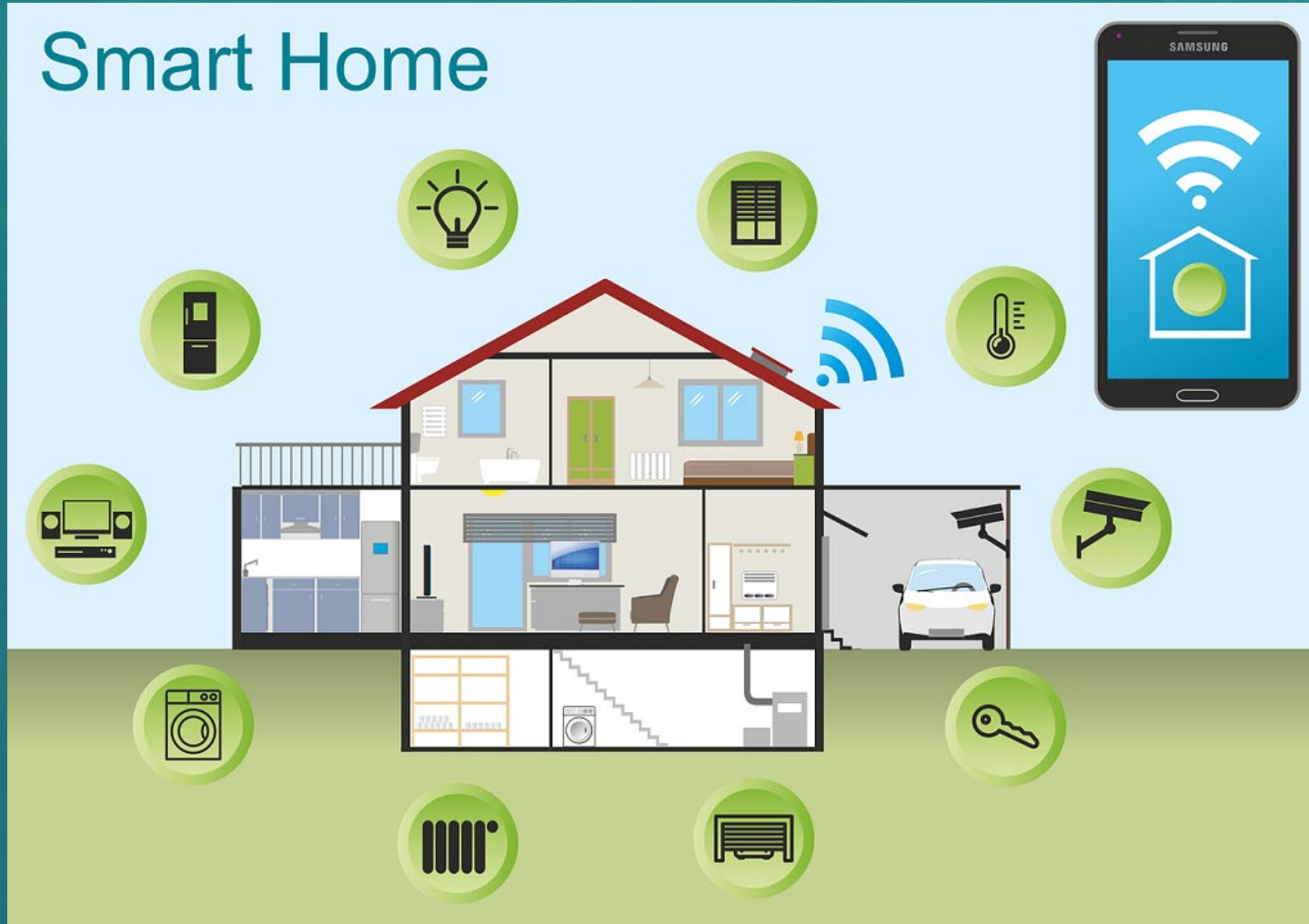
